OFFER DESCRIPTION

Documentary Public Tender for the Recruitment of an Assistant Professor for the Technical Scientific Unit of Visual Arts - disciplinary area of Drawing.

1 - It is made public that, by Dispatch ESE/PR-021/ 2021, of June 14, 2021, of the President of the School of Education of Porto Polytechnic Institute, in the use of its own competence and in accordance with the Regulation of Public Tenders for Recruitment of a Career Teaching Staff of the Porto Polytechnic Institute, Dispatch no. 4807/2011, published in Diário da República, II series, No. 54, of March 17, is open for the period 30 working days from the publication of this notice in the Diário da República, documentary applications are open for recruitment of an Assistant Professor, in the form of employment contract in public functions for indefinite duration, for the technical-scientific area of Visual Arts - disciplinary area of Drawing to the School of Education of Porto Polytechnic Institute, in accordance with the Career Statute for Teaching Staff in Higher Polytechnic Education – Decree-Law no. 185/81 of 1st July, in its republication as it appeared in Decree-Law no. 207/2009, of 31st August, and by Law no. 7/2010, of 13th May, hereby referred to as ECPDESP, as well as the Dispatch no. 4807/2011, published in Diário da República, II series, of 17/03/2011.

2 - ~~Period of validity~~ - the present competition is exclusively aimed at filling the aforementioned vacant position in the respective staffing chart and will expire when it is filled or there are insufficient candidates.

3 - Work place - School of Education of Porto Polytechnic Institute located at Rua Dr. Roberto Frias, No. 602, 4200-465 Porto.

4 - Category functional content – as described in no.4 of article 3rd of the ECPDESP.

5 - Admission requirements:

5.1 - Be in possession of the requirements set forth in paragraphs b) to e) of article 17 of the General Law on Work in Public Functions, approved by Law No. 35-A/2014, of June 20.

5.2 - In compliance with article 17 of the ECPDESP, holders of a PhD degree or the title of specialist in the area for which the competition is open are eligible to apply. Applicants holding qualifications obtained abroad must prove the recognition, equivalence, or registration of the doctoral degree under the terms of the applicable legislation.

6 - Application procedures:

6.1 - The application is made by electronic means, through the address:

<https://portal.ipp.pt/concursos/ese/pessoal> by the deadline for the submission of applications referred to in point 1 of this notice.

The application is presented in Portuguese through a dated and signed request for admission to the competition, addressed to the President of the School of Education of Porto Polytechnic Institute and should contain, among others, the following elements:

(a) Identification of the applicant by name, date of birth, nationality, civil and tax identification number, postal and electronic address, and telephone numbers;

b) Identification of the tendering procedure that is the object of the application;

c) Indication of the category and institution where he / she provides teaching service, when applicable, and position currently held;

d) Indication of the degrees and academic titles held by the applicant;

e) Declaration of the veracity of the elements or facts contained in the application;

6.2 - The application is accompanied by the following documentation, in digital format:

a) Detailed Curriculum Vitae, duly dated and signed

b) Copies of works and documents, for the purposes of the assessment provided for in item 11 of this notice, organized by performance criteria in the pedagogical activity, technical-scientific and artistic activity, and other relevant activities in accordance with the parameters provided for in items 8.1, 8.2 and 8.3;

c) Certificate proving ownership and date of attainment of the degree and titles required for the tender;

d) Number and validity of the identity card or citizen card;

e) Criminal record certificate;

f) Document proving the physical robustness and psychic profile, indispensable to the exercise of the functions;

g) Updated compulsory vaccination bulletin;

h) List of documents accompanying the application.

6.3 - The documents referred to in items f), g), and h) of the previous number may be replaced by a declaration provided in the application, under oath, in which, in separate paragraphs, the candidate must define his/her precise situation regarding the content of each of those items.

6.4 - The documents must be presented in Portuguese or English (or exceptionally in another foreign language, and the Jury may, by deliberation, require their translation).

6.5 - Failure to present the documents required in this announcement or presenting them after the deadline stipulated in no. 1 of this Announcement determines exclusion from the application.

6.6 - Failure to present documents related to the submitted curriculum by the candidate will result in the non-valuation of the elements that they should prove.

6.7 - Provision of fake documents determines immediate withdrawal from the application process and notification to the proper authority for criminal proceedings.

6.8 - Whenever deemed necessary, the jury may request candidates to submit additional documentation related to the submitted curriculum.

7 - The curriculum vitae must show a balance between pedagogical, technical-scientific, and artistic competencies, as well as competencies in other relevant areas, and their suitability for teaching in a Polytechnic School of Education, translated into previous teaching experience in artistic training, training of Cultural Mediators, Education Technicians, and Teachers, in the scientific area and disciplinary area for which the tender is open.

8 - Selection and ranking criteria of candidates – In compliance with the terms of article 15º-A of the ECPDESP and article 20th of the Regulation of the Public Tender for Recruitment of Career Teaching Staff of the Polytechnic Institute of Porto, the Technical and Scientific Board of the School of Education ratified the following selection and ranking criteria of candidates, in order to ascertain the merit of the candidates for the tasks to be performed, to which the following weight has been assigned:

a) Pedagogical Activity (PA) - relative weight of 45%

b) Technical-scientific and artistic activity (TSAA) - relative weight of 30%

c) Other Relevant Activities (ORA) - relative weight of 25%.

8.1 - Pedagogical activity. In assessing pedagogical merit, the following parameters will be considered:

8.1.1 - Professional experience in the scientific-artistic domain in which the tender is open and duration of the activities carried out;

8.1.2 - Teaching of curricular units, framed in different study cycles - orientation of internships, seminars, laboratory or field work (in the assessment of these parameters the number and diversity of the curricular units taught should be taken into consideration);

8.1.3 - Authorship, co-authoring of curricular unit programs, framed in different study cycles, and respective scientific responsibility;

8.1.4 - Capacity for pedagogical innovation - development of pedagogical, scientific, artistic and technical activities; promotion of pedagogical initiatives aimed at improving teaching and learning processes; preparation of courses or new curricular units; participation in educational structures; promotion and dynamization of processes to improve the pedagogical activity of study cycles or other teaching activities (when assessing this parameter, the number, nature and diversity of activities should be taken into account);

8.1.5 – Pedagogical experience in Primary Education, in the areas of teaching, educational guidance and the performance of other educational functions, namely pedagogical coordination and supervision, and fostering the school's relationship with the community.

6.2. Technical-scientific and artistic activity. In assessing this performance, the following parameters will be considered:

8.2.1 - Scientific and technical production, books, book chapters, articles in scientific journals (with and without arbitration) and in minutes of scientific meetings, as well as conferences, active participation in colloquia, congresses, seminars, conferences and others scientific forums (in the evaluation of this parameter the quantity, originality and diversity of production as well as the degree of internationalization must be taken into account);

8.2.2 - Projects - coordination and participation in research and innovation projects, with national, international, public or private funding, as well as non-funded projects (in the assessment of this parameter the type of involvement of the researcher (coordinator or participant), the degree of insertion of the project (national or international network) and the insertion in a research structure should be taken into account);

8.2.3 - Scientific Orientation - orientation of dissertations and/or projects, and scientific orientation of faculty;

8.2.4 - Jury for dissertation/project/internship report for masters, doctorate, specialist;

8.2.5 - Coordination, execution and development of projects or artistic and cultural activities - Realization, publication and presentation of artistic and cultural work in the scope of Communication Design, Sound and Image Production, Photography, Production of digital works, Multimedia publications.

8.2.6 - Organization and participation in cultural and artistic dissemination and promotion events

8.2 - Other relevant activities. In assessing this performance, the following parameters will be considered;

8.3.1 - Participation in statutory, middle management, and pedagogical bodies in higher education (considering the time and diversity of the positions);

8.3.2 - Participation in selection and ranking juries (ex: Master's degree, special tenders, tenders over 23 years old, prerequisites), considering the type of involvement of the candidate (president or member);

8.3.3. Extension Activities - Providing services to the community in the scope of training, consulting and intervention;

8.4 - In compliance with the terms of point 3 of the article 20th of the Regulation of the Public Tender for Recruitment of Career Teaching Staff of the Porto Polytechnic Institute, teachers in the exercise of management positions in the respective schools / institute and free from teaching functions by virtue of the application of legal or statutory regulations or by determination of the competent bodies should not be disadvantaged in the application of the grid defined by the jury for the parameter referred to in point 8.1 of this notice.

9 - Evaluation and Selection:

9.1 – The operation of the jury is framed by the article 12th of the Regulation of Public Tender for Recruitment of Career Teaching Staff of the Porto Polytechnic Institute.

9.2 - Once the deadline for submitting applications has ended, the jury must meet and deliberate on the admission and exclusion of the applications, under the terms foreseen in Article 17 of the Regulation of the Public Tender for Recruitment of Career Teaching Staff of the Porto Polytechnic Institute.

9.3 - The evaluation of the candidates admitted to the competition will be made according to the approved criteria, parameters and weights.

9.4 - The deliberations of the jury shall be taken by absolute majority of votes of the members present at the meeting, in which no abstentions will be allowed.

10 - A favourable vote of approval in absolute merit, explicitly resulting from the respective written rationale based on a qualitative analysis of the documents submitted with the application, will be awarded to the candidate who evidences the ability and a performance deemed appropriate for the duties of Assistant Professor, both at the pedagogical and scientific level, or at the level of other activities developed

11 - The final grade, on a scale of 0 to 100 points, assigned by each member of the Jury will be obtained by the following formula: $FGJM = 0.45*PA + 0.30*TSAA + 0.25*ORA$, where FGJM corresponds to the Final Grade of the Jury Member; AP = sum of the scores given to the candidate in the component referring to Pedagogical Activity, TSAA = sum of the scores given to the candidate in the component referring to the Technical, Scientific and Artistic Activity, OA = sum of the scores given to the candidate in the component referring to the Other

Relevant Activities, considering approved in absolute merit candidates who obtain a final grade equal to or higher than 50 points and non-approved candidates who obtain a final grade lower than that score.

12 - Are grounds for exclusion from the present procedure:

a) Obtaining a valuation lower than the defined in this notice or by the jury as considered for approval on absolute merit;

b) Obtaining a final score of less than 50 points, as a result of applying the formula in point 11 of the present notice.

13— Participation of interested parties and decision:

13.1 - The final ranking project is notified to the candidates, for the purposes of hearing the interested parties, pursuant to article 121 and following of the Administrative Procedure Code, applying the provisions of article 19 of the Regulation.

13.2 - After hearing the interested parties, the jury appreciates the offered allegations and approves the final ranking list of the candidates.

14 - Jury composition
